General Information

Competitors MUST report to the backstage managers at least one full section before their section to allow for the smooth running of the Eisteddfod.

1. Time Limits

Solos

- 6 Years and Under 2.5 minutes
- 12 Years and Under 3 minutes
- 13 Years and Over 3 minutes

All Song and Dance 4 minutes

Duos and Trios 4 minutes

- **2. Restricted Sections:** Apply to competitors who have never won a First Prize in this type of dance at any Eisteddfod prior to the entry closing date.
- **3. National Character Dances**: Competitors are not permitted to perform Highland, Irish or Sailor Dance routines.
- **4. Improvisations:** Competitors in these sections will dance after listening to the music once. All music will be set by the Adjudicator. Tights and plain leotards and appropriated footwear only are to be worn.
- **5. Championship Qualifications:** Two contrasting routines are performed. To be eligible for a Championship, a competitor must have previously competed in TWO contrasting types of dances in this Eisteddfod, in their own age group.
 - BALLET Classical and Demi-Character.
 - TAP Must be Fast and any other routine from either Slow, Waltz or Non-Waltz.
 - JAZZ Modern Expressive and Jazz.
- **6. Modern/ Contemporary & National Championships:** only one routine needed to qualify, but TWO routines to be performed.
- 7. **Hip Hop Championship:** only one routine needed to qualify and one routine to be performed. No repeat performances. Restricted, Improvisation, and Song and Dance sections are not eligible to qualify.
- **8. Repeats**: Competitors are not permitted to perform the same routine in more than one section.
- **9. Competitors:** can compete only in one section in Dance, except in groups where up to two substitutes will be permitted owing to illness or absence. If this occurs, the Leeton Eisteddfod Convenors are to be notified prior to performing.
- **10. Competitors in Duo or Trio Sections:** may compete more than once in the section as long as they are dancing a different type of dance such as tap or jazz i.e., they can not do two dances of the same type.
- **11. Competitors in Demi Character and Song and Dance:** may only have two large props (table and chair as one), and a small carry-on prop for a solo.
- **12. Complaints / Protests:** These must be in writing to the Dance Convenor together with a fee of \$10 within 30 minutes of the completion of the section or in the case of a problem with a member of the staging team i.e., a penciller must be in before the completion of the first section of the session.
- **13.** Rosin is not permitted to be used by dancers on their shoes.
- **14.** All dancers compete at their own risk.
- **15. Sections:** In any section where there are less than two (2) competitors, sections may be combined, deleted, or cancelled at the discretion of the Leeton Eisteddfod Committee, prior to the commencement of the Eisteddfod. If there are insufficient entries in some sections, the age restrictions or students may be asked to dance up. Dance convenors will contact the parents, schools and or teachers are informed of any changes prior to the printing of the program.

To allow students to gain experience dancing on stage, if there is only one entry and the section is still allowed to continue (at the dance convenors discretion) no placing will be issued, only critique will be given.

16. Prizes Awarded

Prizes will be awarded at the convenors and or adjudicator's discretion, as follows:

- 1–3 Competitors 1st Prize Only
- 4- 7 Competitors 1st and 2nd Prizes
- 8 or more Competitors 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prizes
- **17. Child Protection**, due to child protection policies, no photography is allowed of performers onstage, backstage or dressing room areas, except by the official photographer registered with Leeton Eisteddfod Society Inc who will be wearing a vest. Offenders may be asked to leave.

Leeton Eisteddfod Society Inc. takes the safety of children and vulnerable people seriously. We follow all guidelines as per the Office of the Children's Guardian and ensure that all members, volunteers, teachers, and adjudicators also comply.

Amanda has been teaching for over 40 years. She is a qualified RAD classical ballet teacher, a contemporary and lyrical choreographer and teacher and an ISTD jazz and tap tutor. Professional engagements include the Australian Ballet Company as soloist, the Bayerische Staatsballet (Munich, Germany) as soloist, Principal Guest Artist for the Jessica Iwanson.

Contemporary Dance Company (Munich, Germany). Amanda's vocal and piano studies at the Conservatorium of Music (Sydney) enabled her to pursue a singing career upon her return to Australia. She was lead vocalist with Mo Award nominated 'Network' performing nationally and internationally. Amanda has also appeared in several acting roles including Sons and Daughters, Ben Hall, Return to Eden and Bodyline.

Upon Amanda's return to Australia she founded Dance North Academy which saw many students go onto professional careers in dance and to establish their own dance schools. Amanda is a competition choreographer and coach, international ballet/contemporary company liaison, and an international and national adjudicator. She hopes to pass on her extensive knowledge in a constructive and encouraging way and to share her love of all things dance and performance.

AGE DANCING AGGREGATE AWARDS

Age Dancing Aggregate Awards will be awarded to the competitor who acquires the highest aggregate points in their own age group, across all dances. In the case of a tied result, the competitor with the greatest number of first places will receive the award.

The points for the Age Aggregate are awarded based on 1^{st} place = 6 points, 2^{nd} place = 3 points and 3^{rd} place = 1 point.

ADJUDICATOR SPECIAL AWARDS

Shirley Collins Memorial Trophy (IP)

Awarded to the most promising dancer in the Classical Ballet restricted section 8 years and under, 10 years and under and 12 years and under. No entry required. Note: Previous winners of this trophy are not eligible.

Johnstone Trophy

Awarded to the most promising dancer in Tap dance restricted section 347, 360 and 376. No entry required. Note: Previous winners of this trophy are not eligible.

Dancing Premiership (IP)

Awarded to the competitor gaining the highest aggregate in their own age group performances in the Classical Ballet, Demi Character, National Character, Song and Dance (soft shoe) and Modern Dance sections. No entry required.

Margaret Fulton Incentive Award (IP)

An incentive award for a competitor 13 years and over who shows potential and needs encouragement. No entry required.

G & B Fitzsimons Incentive Award (IP)

An incentive award for a competitor 12 years and over who shows potential and needs encouragement. No entry required.

Jennifer Killeen Cup (IP)

Awarded to the most promising ballet dancer of the Eisteddfod. No entry required.

Linda Scaife Award (IP)

Awarded to the most promising revue dancer of the Eisteddfod, to be selected from performances in Jazz, Song and Dance and Tap Dance. No entry required.

Whymark Family Awards

Awarded to competitors from a Leeton dance school who have not received a first place during the Eisteddfod in any form of solo dance. There are three awards – 8 years and under, 12 years and under, 13 years and over.

Rebecca Burton Award

Awarded to the most promising 12 years and under Tap Dancer.

Sarah Burton Award

Awarded to the most promising 13 years and under Tap Dancer.

Genna Andracchio Award (IP)

Awarded to the most promising Contemporary Dancer throughout the Eisteddfod.
