LEETON EISTEDDFOD

The first annual Eisteddfod will be held in Leeton on Wednesday and Thursday, 8th and 9th December at the Leeton School of Arts. There will be two sessions each day. A committee comprising the leading people of the town and district has been formed and it is expected with such a strong committee a very fine result will be achieved. The committee has done the right thing in securing the services of Mr Bennett North, the leading adjudicator of the State, who has adjudicated at Newcastle, Bathurst, Kempsey, Wollongong, Wagga, Armidale, Lithgow, besides other places. Press reports of the adjudicating at Newcastle state: "it was of surpassing excellence, interesting to the audience as well as the competitors." Mr Bennett North and Dr. W. G. McNaught (known throughout Great Britain as the "Prince of Adjudicators") often worked in conjunction. Mr Bennett North has also been associated with the Halle Choir, Manchester, The Orpheous Glee Society and with Dame Clara Butt, Madam Ada Crossley, Madame Elsa Stralla, Madame D'Alvarez and Dr. Brodsky.

The Eisteddfod will be held under the auspices of the Methodist Church and the schedule, which will be available next week, will provide for recitations for children and adults, musical monologues, Shakespearian recitals, impromptu readings soprano, contralto, tenor and bass solos; mixed duets, male quartets, ladies' duets church choir choral competition, juvenile choir, action songs, instrumental pieces, piano, violin and brass, for children and adults; also for orchestras. The adjudicator will also be asked to award a championship prize for the best piece at the Eisteddfod.

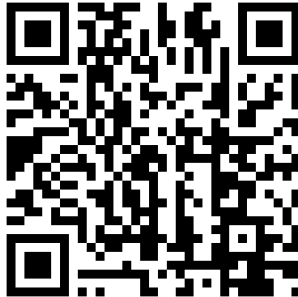

Aggregate Awards / Scholarships

Age Dancing Aggregate Awards will be awarded to the competitor who acquires the highest aggregate points in their own age group, across all dances. In the case of a tied result, the competitor with the greatest number of first places will receive the award.

1 st place = 6 points, 2nd place = 3 points and 3 rd. place = 1 point.

Mrs Lena Di-Salvatore Memorial Dancing Premiership Trophy and \$100 Sponsored by Leeton Eisteddfod Society Awarded to the competitor gaining the highest aggregate in their own age group performances in Classical Ballet, Demi Character, National Character, Modern and Jazz sections. No entry required.

Shirley Collins Memorial Trophy (IP) sponsored by Leanne Martin Awarded to the most promising dancer in the Classical Ballet restricted section 8 years and under, 10 years and under and 12 years and under. No entry required.

Note: Previous winners of this trophy are not eligible.

Johnstone Trophy Awarded to the most promising dancer in Tap dance restricted section 347, 360 and 376. No entry required. Note: Previous winners of this trophy are not eligible.

Margaret Fulton Incentive Award (IP) An incentive award for a competitor 13 years and over who shows potential and needs encouragement. No entry required.

G & B Fitzsimons Incentive Award (IP) An incentive award for a competitor 12 years and over who shows potential and needs encouragement. No entry required.

Jennifer Killeen Cup (IP) Awarded to the most promising ballet dancer of the Eisteddfod. No entry required.

Linda Scaife Award (IP) Awarded to the most promising revue dancer of the Eisteddfod, to be selected from performances in Jazz, Song and Dance and Tap Dance. No entry required.

Whymark Family Awards Awarded to competitors from a Leeton dance school who have not received a first place during the Eisteddfod in any form of solo dance. There are three awards – 8 years and under, 12 years and under, 13 years and over.

Rebecca Burton Award Awarded to the most promising 12 years and under Tap Dancer.

Sarah Burton Award Awarded to the most promising 13 years and under Tap Dancer.

Genna Andracchio Award (IP) Awarded to the most promising Contemporary Dancer throughout the Eisteddfod.

Adjudicator: Paul Jarman



Paul Jarman is an acclaimed composer, lyricist, conductor & performer. One of Australia's most celebrated choral composers, Paul has written over 300 commissioned works & 100 school anthems. At the forefront of the modern wave of Australian choral music, Paul is regarded for his inclusive projects, storytelling and melodies. Many of Paul's works have become modern choral standards. He is proudly self-published worldwide.

Paul has long standing associations with many of Australia's arts

organisations & has been the composer/conductor in residence for hundreds of schools across Australia & the Diversity Artist in residence in China at Dulwich College International since 2014. In Australia's pioneering world music group, Sirocco, Paul performed as a cultural ambassador from 1996 – 2012 in festivals & events worldwide & with various other ensembles & choirs throughout Europe, North America & the Pacific Islands, including commemorations for Centenary of WW1.

Paul's work for the 40th Anniversary of the death of Martin Luther King Jnr was performed for President Barack Obama in the White House and in 2016, Paul was the only composer from the Southern Hemisphere, commissioned by Oxford University Press to write a piece for the 400th Anniversary of the death of William Shakespeare.
