Competitors **MUST** report to the Music Convenors at least one full section before their section to allow for the smooth running of the Eisteddfod.

1. ****ALL COMPETITORS – DIGITAL SCORES REQUIRED**** A copy of the music selection is to be provided digitally to the adjudicator as **individual files**. Files to be emailed to leetoneisteddfod@gmail.com by each competitor, schools, bands, groups etc before **5pm on Sunday 20 August 2023**. Music must be clearly marked as below:

2. Time Limits

Maximum length of items is as follows:

16 years & over, including solos, duo/trio, ensemble/bands **5 mins**

12 years to 14 years, including solos, duo/trio, ensemble/bands **4 mins**

10 years & under, including solos, duo/trio, ensemble/ bands **3mins**

Championship sections, Solo **10 mins**

Bands **12 mins**

3. Prizes will be awarded, at the adjudicator's discretion, as follows:
 - 1 – 3 Competitors - 1st Prize Only
 - 4 - 7 Competitors – 1st and 2nd Prizes
 - 8 or more Competitors - 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Prizes
4. **Child Protection**, due to child protection policies, no photography is allowed of performers onstage, backstage or dressing room areas, except by the official photographer registered with Leeton Eisteddfod Society Inc who will be wearing a vest. Offenders may be asked to leave.
5. Competitors must provide their own accompanist.
6. School sections:
 - a. No school may combine with another school unless stated.
 - b. Teachers may NOT perform in ANY school sections, except to conduct or accompany.
 - c. No costumes are to be worn in school group sections, unless otherwise stipulated.
 - d. A 'concert band' consist members of the woodwind, brass, and percussion families of instruments – there may be **no** vocal part, unless otherwise stipulated.
 - e. String ensembles and orchestras also have **no** vocal part, unless otherwise stipulated.
7. No microphones unless otherwise stipulated.
8. To enter a Championship Section, competitors must have competed in two solo items prior to the championship.
9. Competitors may enter multiple categories; however, competitors are not to repeat ANY PIECE OF MUSIC PREVIOUSLY PERFORMED IN THE LEETON EISTEDDFOD.
10. The society will provide a piano for accompaniment, they will also provide facilities required to play from CD, USB or phone connection.
11. It is the responsibility of the performer to ensure that their performance is not in breach of copyright.
12. **Vocal Competitors** Competitor can compete twice in a Section only if performing with a different partner in Duet or Trio sections.
13. **Choral Groups** The piano will be placed and must remain at the left-hand side of the stage as the conductor faces the choir.
14. **Pianoforte Competitors** A Competitor can only compete twice in a Section if performing with a different partner in Duet or Trio sections.
15. **Instrumental Competitors** In all instrumental sections, "**INSTRUMENTAL**" means any instrument other than piano. A Competitor can perform twice in the same section only if performing with a different instrument.

Adjudicator Helena Kernaghan



Helena Kernaghan has established herself as one of the most versatile pianists and musicians of recent times. She has forged her own unique path in the Australian music scene and has managed to do so from her hometown on the NSW-Victorian border, Albury.

Helena finished her master's in music performance at the University of Melbourne (VCA) in 2005 after studying with Donna Coleman & Caroline Almonte. During her time in Melbourne, she became an in-demand chamber musician, accompanist, repetiteur, and soloist. She has performed throughout Australia and internationally and was a founding member of the award-winning Abraxas Piano Trio in 1997. Since then, chamber music (piano trio in particular) has been

her primary focus and love, and she is now a member of the Orpheus Trio with violinist Kaori Sparks and cellist Sam Goble.

A passionate music educator, Helena works with students across all formats and settings and works closely with the next generation of up-and-coming talent. Since 2006 Helena has lived in regional Australia (Albury) enjoying the challenge of teaching and maintaining an active performing life. In this time, she has focused on family life, classroom and private teaching, MD work for productions, working with the Orpheus Piano Trio and continuing her work as a duo-pianist. In recent times she has performed with Dutch thereminist Thorwald Jorgensen, pianist Donna Coleman, clarinettist David Griffiths, tenor Shanul Sharma, & soprano Ayse Goknur-Shanal.

Helena found the perfect creative outlet for her musical, educational and managerial skills as the founding Artistic Director of the Albury Chamber Music Festival. (2016-2019). She is now the artistic director and CEO of an exciting new venture, Murray River Fine Music which was launched in 2021 with a performance by Lior and the Border Quartet.

Helena also enjoys working with artists across various genres and performance styles. In 2021 Helena composed and performed a soundtrack for a children's story 'The River' for the 2021 Upstream Festival. She also provided a musical accompaniment for an abstract game of chess enacted by circus arts performers. She is currently composing a soundtrack for an original play by actor/playwright Kerry Beatty, which will be launched in March 2022.
